Location

The festival campsite is situated in the Spoorpark, Tilburg, the Netherlands. The festival area and campsite are located on the large green field in the park.





How to get there

Train

If you come to the festival by train, it's about a 800 meter/10 minutes walk from the train station (1) to the park entrance (2).

Car

If you come by car, there are paid parking spaces on the streets around the park, also a parking garage (3) is nearby. This parking garage is located at Gasthuisring 60, 5041 DT Tilburg. If you want to park your car for free there are free parking spots at the Reitseplein (4). Do make sure to remove all valuables if you park here. At (5) is a supermarket located.

We don't know the fee of the different parkings. The local government regularly changes the parking fees, therefore we recommend you to check prices online before arrival.

Campsite

We'd love to welcome you on the campsite of the Redhead Days festival, the world's largest and oldest Redhead Days gathering. The



goal of this event is to bring redheads from around the globe together and provide them a life-changing experience and a lot of fun.

At the campsite, there will be a campfire as well. In case you really need your peace and quiet, you can sleep in the calmer "Stadscamping area". At arrival, please ask at the check-in where you can place your tent. Be aware, when it's full at the Stadscamping area, it's really full there and we only have place for you at the festival camping.

Arrival

You can arrive on Friday, Saturday or Sunday. You can come to the entrance off the campsite (see *3 in Location*).

Arrival on Friday is best after 14.00 hrs . Might you arrive before – it's possible we are still working to get the campsite and festival area perfect. If you'd like to help in this case that would be absolutely perfect! ©

The rest of the weekend you can arrive between 9.00 and 17.00 hrs. If you arrive late (or early), of course we can arrange something for



you. Please let us know by e-mail if that's the case. Around 17.00 hrs every afternoon Angela will check to see if there are any messages from people who will be arriving late.

Support and catering

Rental tents

If you have rented a tent, please mention this at check-in and you will be given the number of your tent. The tent including the reserved amount of air-mattresses will be available for you. Note: sleeping bags, blankets or pillows are NOT provided.

After the festival, please hand in the sign with your tent number and one of our volunteers will help check you out. They will check whether the tent is left in a correct state (if it's still clean, intact, etc.). If there is any damage to the tent, you're liable for the damage. All the tents are brand new. Damage fee will be €100,00 if it occurs. Please handle our goods with care.

If the tent is not clean, you will be asked to clean the tent. The only thing your tent will contain is a 1p air matrass for each person you have placed the order for.

Booked only a camping spot?

Please do not forget to bring your own tent/bed/sleeping bag/etc. ☺



Camper/caravan

You need to <u>reserve a camping spot for yourself & anyone who will</u> <u>stay</u> in your camper/caravan and <u>an additional ticket</u> for each camper/caravan place.

The places for a camper or caravan will be assigned to you upon arrival. Do note: some places will not have electricity or water!

Showers and toilets

Showers and toilets are available at the campsite & festival area. Please leave these in a proper state after use so other people enjoy them as well.

Power/WiFi

No power sockets are present on the field, but there are a few spots, such as the reception tent where you can charge your phone. The camping has WiFi available, only the signal is weak and overloaded most of the time – so please make sure you do not need to rely on the Wi-Fi.

Reservation and pay methods

Please buy your camping tickets well in advance of the festival in our <u>webshop</u> before the festival. This way you will be assured of a camping spot. When you book the ticket in the <u>webshop</u>, you will



have to pay up front. Purchases can be made by iDeal, Credit Card, etc. Do note: tickets are not physical, it will be a list at the entrance of the campsite where you can sign in and get your bracelet.

Might you like living on the edge and do not reserve your spot via the webshop, we can still place you as long as the campsite is not sold out.

Same goes for rental tents and camper places. When not reserved via the webshop, we might sell out.

When you still need to pay upon arrival, you can pay in cash or by card at the entrance of the campsite.

Food

Breakfast (times t.b.a.)

Your camping ticket includes free breakfasts. If you don't stay at the campsite but do want to join all the fun & food in the morning, you can buy a ticket for breakfast for €6,00 per breakfast per person. You will find the tickets in the <u>webshop</u>.

Dinner

Bonfire

If the weather conditions allow it, we will be having a bonfire every night. We suggest bringing your own drinks.

Hot tub

In 2022 we introduced the hot tub on our campsite and it was a big success, therefore we decided to have two last year and it was a big hit again. Therefore, they are coming back in 2024! Please note: access to the hot tub is only allowed wearing a bathing suit, so don't forget to bring your swimsuit!

Children are only allowed in with an adult.

Friday

After the dinner the people who will attend the kickoff party will go into the city center.

Saturday

12.00 hrs: Start festival activities

Saturday is a day with about 40 activities. The activity overview and time schedule will be announced later.

TBA: Pubcrawl

We close the day with the pub crawl. It's the party of the year, organized by a brand new organizing team this year – so it's going to be spectacular as ever.

Tickets will be for sale in the webshop when we have more information. If not sold out they will be available on Saturday at the pub crawl tent as well.



Sunday

14.00 hrs: Big Photoshoot

This photoshoot is only for natural redheads, it's the only activity at the festival that's for redheads only. Non-red haired family and friends can stand close to the photoshoot and will be able to see you, so children are allowed to go on the photoshoot on their own (with of course all other redheads joining the event) if their parents are not redheads.

Note: the time of the photoshoot will be later then you are used to if you are a regular visitor.

17.00 hrs: Dinner

The last organized activity for visitors starts on Sunday around 17.00. More information is to come!

Issues and troubleshooting

Remember this festival is organized by volunteers, so not everything will be perfect, and we also do not aim for perfection. We aim for people to have a great time.

If a problem arises, please inform the organizers and discuss possible solutions. Always be polite to other visitors, even if they are not. Some visitors have jet-lags, or hangovers: just stay polite and when that doesn't help, ask assistance of organizers. There will also be security at the campsite. We hope these guys

don't have to do anything – but they are obligated to be working at



a festival, otherwise it's not allowed to organize one. Please be polite and follow their orders if they give some. They will not give orders without a reason. ©

Are you okay?

We all can name examples of inappropriate sexual behavior, weather we have experienced it ourselves or know somebody who experienced it.

At this festival we do not tolerate any inappropriate behavior. If you are not comfortable on how somebody treats you, please find a member of the organization and tell your story. We will find a solution together. If there is nobody in the area where you are, please use the emergency phone number (see "Communication"). Are you the causer of the inappropriate behavior? Then one warning will follow, if the unwanted behavior continues after the warning, the perpetrator must leave the event immediately. At any time of day/night.
